Sanctioning

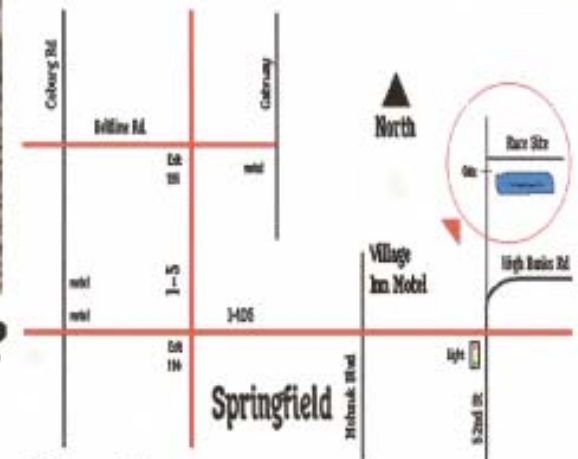
